**SUBJECT: Only a Few Weeks Left to Apply for 2018 Home4Good Funding**

FHLBank Pittsburgh's Home4Good product helps those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness by channeling dollars to local service organizations that know how to help. More than \$7 million in 2018 funding is currently being allocated by FHLBank and its state partners, with the support of FHLBank members.

New 2018 proposals are no longer being accepted in Delaware, but members still have time to co-apply for Home4Good funds to help projects in Pennsylvania (proposals due Sept. 28) and West Virginia (proposals due Oct. 8).
