SUBJECT: \$30 Million in 2018 Affordable Housing Program Funds Now Available

The 2018 funding round for the Affordable Housing Program (AHP) is now open **with approximately \$30 million** in available funding. Applications are due by 5 p.m. Eastern time on Thursday, Aug. 9. The awarded projects will be announced on Thursday, Dec. 13.
