SUBJECT: AHP Opens June 17 with Approximately \$31 Million in Funding

The 2019 funding round of the Affordable Housing Program (AHP) will open on **Monday, June 17, with approximately \$31 million** in available funding. The resources below can help you get ready for this year's funding round, since early planning will help your application be more competitive.

To discuss specific eligibility, scoring or feasibility issues and questions, project sponsors and members may request technical assistance from FHLBank staff through the Technical Assistance Request Form, which will be available online beginning March 25. Technical assistance for 2019 AHP projects will be available April 1 through June 28.*

As a reminder, 2019 AHP applications are due on Thursday, Aug. 8. The awarded projects will be announced on Thursday, Dec. 19.
