SUBJECT: 2019 Affordable Housing Program Resources

The 2019 funding round of the Affordable Housing Program (AHP) will open on **Monday, June 17, with approximately \$31 million** in available funding. Updated forms, guides and application attachments are available on the [Bank's website](#). Resources available for the 2019 AHP round are highlighted below.

<i>New guides for applying in the updated system</i>	<p>Several AHP application questions and documentation requirements changed when the AHP Online system was updated in January. All applicants should review the updated application paper guide, which outlines all the application questions, prior to completing their application in the AHP Online system.</p> <p>On June 17, new sponsor and member AHP Online Application Guides will be available on the Bank's website. These guides detail the steps and screens you will encounter as you complete your AHP application in the updated system.</p>
<i>Webinars</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• AHP 101 Webinar – This webinar provides a detailed discussion of the AHP process, including key scoring and feasibility factors.• Community Stability Webinar – This webinar defines the scoring elements and describes the documentation necessary to earn Community Stability points in the AHP application.• AHP Tips Webinar – Initiate your application by July 10 to receive a July 11 invitation to view the AHP Tips Webinar, which provides insight into a successful AHP application.
<i>Partner matching</i>	<p>Members and project sponsors looking for a partner for this year's funding round can request matching help by completing the AHP Member/Sponsor Match form.</p>
<i>Technical assistance</i>	<p>To discuss specific eligibility, scoring or feasibility considerations and questions, project sponsors and members may request technical assistance from FHLBank staff through the Technical Assistance Request Form. Technical assistance for 2019 AHP projects is available through June 28.*</p>
