2020 AHP Forms, Guides and Resources Now Available

The 2020 funding round of the Affordable Housing Program (AHP) will open on **Monday, June 15, with approximately \$28.6 million** in available funding.

- **Partner Matching** – Members and project sponsors looking for a member/sponsor partner for this year's round can get matching help through the [AHP Match Request Form](#).

The following webinar will also be available for the 2020 funding round:

- **AHP Tips Webinar** – Those who initiate their 2020 AHP application by July 10 will receive, on July 13, a link to the AHP Tips Webinar. This webinar will highlight tips for submitting a successful AHP application.

2020 AHP applications are due by 5 p.m. Eastern time on Aug. 11, and the awarded projects will be announced on Dec. 18. Early application planning will help ensure that your application will be competitive for funding.
