

FHLBank Update

2020 AHP Application Assistance Request Period Is Now Closed

Application assistance requests related to specific eligibility, scoring and feasibility considerations for the 2020 Affordable Housing Program (AHP) funding round will no longer be accepted as of 5 p.m. Eastern today, June 30. Requests submitted prior to that time will be reviewed and scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Assistance for the 2020 AHP funding round is now limited to AHP Online system technical functionality issues only (e.g., system login or financial feasibility spreadsheet upload issues). Approximately \$28.6 million in AHP funding is available this year. All 2020 forms, guides and application attachments are available on [FHLBank's website](#). Additional resources are highlighted below.

As a reminder, 2020 AHP applications are due by **5 p.m. Eastern on Tuesday, Aug. 11**. Awarded projects will be announced on Friday, Dec. 18.
